# CHAIRMAN WAGNER ANNOUNCES ORANGE COUNTY HALL OF FAME

# MISSION VIEJO GIRL SCOUTS' SILVER AWARD

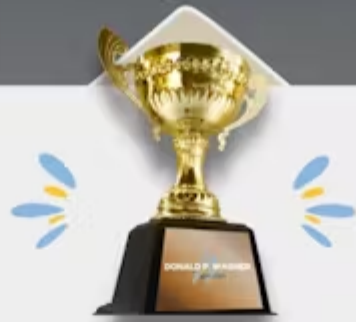
